1. Band VP Student Treasurer: Jakob Kreibick

- (b) HBBC Organizational Guidelines (by-laws) updates: Motion to propose the following changes to the bylaws under the Regular Meetings heading: Larry G/Lisa R
 - (i) Current: General membership meetings of the Hempfield Band Booster Club will be held, at minimum, in the months of August, September, October, December, February, and March at 7:00 p.m. at Hempfield High School.
 - (ii) Change to: General membership meetings of the Hempfield Band Booster Club will be held, at minimum, 8 months of the year (March meeting required for voting of elected officers for the following season). Meetings are held at 7:00 p.m. at Hempfield High School.
 - (iii) Voting on the above will happen at the February HBBC meeting.
- (c) Due to his return to school, Scott will not be continuing as the President in the upcoming band season. Anyone who is interested in the position can contact him or they can formally nominate another band parent, as long as they have had a conversation with them regarding the position. Voting will be in March. We are also in need of a new treasurer and VP of festivals, shadow next year.

5. HBBC Treasurer Report: Patrick Long

- (a) Balances: \$46,323.71 (booster club funds) + \$225.15 (outstanding deposits) \$10,909.70 (outstanding checks mainly indoor ensemble expenses) \$4,000 reserved funds = \$31,639.16 + \$6,041.10 (member accounts) = \$37,680.26 total combined funds
- (b) December RaiseRight \$709.54

8. New Business

- (a) Matthew C: At the Cavalcade of Bands meeting, there was discussion regarding shortening the season by a week so that it would end prior to DST ending. Some bands don't have the ability to practice under lights the final week. However, Hershey stadium already has a contract for that weekend. Wondered if there would be 3-4 high schools that would host a Cavalcade division, ie. Yankee/Patriot, championship. They contacted local universities, but they aren't options. After some discussion, we said we would consider it, however it would be in addition to Opening Knight and would need more information.
